MINUTES OF THE NOVEMBER 7, 1992 EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING

Present Committee assignments were reviewed and the decision made to leave them as they stand.

A question was raised as to whether we should sponsor an award plaque for the NH QSO Party at a cost of \$40.00. After much discussion it was decided that it would not be in our best interest and the subject was dropped.

On a motion by W1JY, seconded by K1NYS it was voted to join the New Hampshire Amateur Radio Association and the Treasurer was authorized to send them a check for \$15.00 for one years dues.

The Spring Meeting was scheduled for Saturday May 15, 1993 at a place to be determined. The Executive Committee members are researching places and prices. We hope to be able to make a decision at the next Executive Committee meeting which is scheduled for Saturday February 27, 1993 at a time and place to be announced.

The question of whether we should have a raffle or flea market (or some combination) at the Spring Meeting was raised. Rather than commit at this point it was decided to solicit an opinion from the membership. Therefore, when you send in your 1993 dues please include your comments on this subject.

Speaking of dues, now is the time for payment of your 1993 dues. Our Treasurer will be most happy to hear from you and will forward your raffle/flea market comments to the Executive committee.
