Minutes of the Executive Committee Meeting held October 22nd, 1988

President Johnny requested that our Association join the New Hampshire Amateur Radio Association, a group that represents all ham clubs of the state, and that we pay the \$15.00 per year dues. Approved.

It was agreed that all equipment that goes with our repeater would be stored in one place; namely, at Dick's home where the repeater is located. Only one or two items are not on hand at the moment.

Hu reported that Dave Metz had given him a name and address list of hams in the central N.H. area and suggested that we contact them, inviting them both to use the repeater and to join the Association. Approved.

John reported that the new Radio Shack store in the Belknap Mall will be open soon, and that will have a good supply of materials for hams. Also, the store manager would like to be on the Association mailing list. Approved.
