1982-83 NEWS LETTER

The summer of 1982 has been a very eventful one, starting with our May luncheon which took place at the Sportsmen's Club in Gilford. A good time was had by all.

On September 4th, we removed the Station Master antenna and replaced it with a Gam antenna which was donated by WALTVP. Present at the repeater site were: N1ACB, WALTVP, W111Q, WB1FYE, K1MPK, W1KRZ, K1MMF, W1GCU, and K1ELM. K1MMF climbed the tower and W1GCU assisted. Tests were made by N1ACB, and everything was favorable.

At the August meeting, we had an election of officers: K1ELM - President; K1MPK - Vice-President and Treasurer; N1BAE - Secretary.

At this meeting, it was voted to install a telephone at the repeater site, so that we could take advantage of the phone patch facilities. It has been installed at quite an expense as follows: a \$90.00 installation fee, plus a \$250.00 deposit, which will be returned at a later date. We also now have a \$17.00 per month phone bill. In addition to this we have signed a lease of \$10.00 per month for the repeater site. A payment of \$360.00 had to be paid for back rent for the last three years.

We are also in the process of having our own electric meter tied in at the repeater site, which will also be an additional monthly bill.

As you can see, this does not leave us too much capital to operate with for repairs and upgrading of the equipment.

At the present time code no. 2 is in use. When the codes are to be changed the members will be notified.

When you bring up the dial tone..... give your call sign and date.

When you are through..... hit the clear code, give your call sign and announce you are clearing the patch.
